### **2010 FEES & REGISTRATION.**

No player will be permitted to begin playing the season with PH-DSC unless all documentation is completed and all registration fees have been paid in full.

Required at registration is :

- Copy of Proof of Age. – For new registrations up to U/17 only (Passport or birth certificate).
- Registration fees – Cheque or Cash. All fees must be paid in full at time of registration

The registration fees include the following:

- All GHFA Competition Fees.
- Referees Fees.
- Players Insurance.
- “Soccer Australia” and “Gladesville Spirit” levies.
- Training ground hire at Dural Park

### **TEAM COACHING OR MANAGING**

The club is seeking applications for positions of team Coaches and Managers, please consider helping in the development of our children in either of these two important positions with the Club.

Please consider undertaking either of these positions, as a service to the Club and your Children.

### **COMPETITION SOCCER**

All Under 9 to All Age teams play “Competitive Soccer” against other teams of similar skill in the GHFA competition. All teams compete throughout the season, culminating in a championship final series and Grand Final.

ALL MINI and JUNIOR GAMES ARE PLAYED ON SATURDAYS.

Due to field availability and team numbers all Senior teams maybe required to play "one or two" Sunday games during the season.

Where possible all players will be graded within Pacific Hills-Dural Soccer Club teams with other players of similar skill and ability.

*All players must attend team grading days. These are scheduled for Wednesday's 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> February 2010.*

*Team allocations will be announced after Grading Day and Training will commence, the first week in March at Dural Park on either Wednesday or Thursday afternoons/evenings.*

### ***EQUIPMENT.***

The club will provide all teams with the following equipment:

- Club Playing Shirt. (On Loan ONLY).
- All additional Training equipment.
- Match Balls.

All Club equipment remains the property of Pacific Hills-Dural Sports Club Inc., and must be returned at the end of the season. A \$30 replacement fee will be imposed if the club shirt is not returned.

All players are responsible for providing the following equipment:

- Soccer Boots.
- Drink Bottle.
- Club Shorts. #☒
- Club Socks. #☒
- Shin Pads. ☒

# Can be purchased through the Club at registration day or from the “Uniforms Manager”.

☒ : Must be worn by all players : Referees and Coaches/Managers will not permit players on field without the correct Club strip or Shin Pads “NO PADS / NO PLAY”.

### ***MINI SOCCER***

All Under 6 to Under 9 age teams play “Mini Soccer”. Generally, in our children’s early years of sport development their :

- Soccer skills and abilities vary widely.
- Generally lack coordination.
- Have poor balance.
- Natural competitive spirit.
- Forget very quickly the game score.
- Have natural soccer fitness.
- Visual perception of depth and Speed of a moving ball is poor.
- Concentration Span is Limited.

The Mini Soccer modified rules and ground sizes have considered the above factors. Mini soccer is designed and operated to allow the players to have fun, while promoting the players interest and enjoyment of the game and developing individual and team skill, so that they will continue in future years to play senior competitive soccer.

### ***SMALL SIDED GAMES***

GHFA has continued with SSG for Under 6 to under 9 players in 2010.

1. Under 6s will play 4 v 4 and Under 7s 5 v 5 on a 30m x 20m field.
2. Under 8s will play 7 v 7 on a 50m x 35m field
3. Under 9s will play 9 v 9 on a 70 x 45m field.

### ***REFEREEING***

Subject to availability, a “badged” referee coordinated by Gladesville Hornsby Soccer Referees’ Association controls all GHFA competitive soccer.

If you are already qualified to referee please make note on the registration documentation.

### ***COACHING AND REFEREE TRAINING***

The GHFA holds coaching and referee training courses.

### GLADESVILLE-HORNSBY FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

#### CODE OF CONDUCT

Winning at any sport is a part of sporting tradition but this is not as important as the “spirit of the game”.

#### Referees, Assistant Referees and Other Match Officials.

Abuse of referees and assistant referees will not be tolerated in any form.

Abuse includes derogatory comments about the match official’s performance or ability, repeated or vocal criticism or challenging of the match official or their decisions, and any form of insulting, offensive, aggressive or intimidating behaviour or language directed at a match official.

Abuse of referees, assistant referees, players, coaches, managers, parents or spectators etc may result in penalties against the individual, team or club concerned. Those penalties include fines, bonds, loss of competition points and suspension.

#### Coaches and Managers Code of Behaviour.

- be reasonable in your demands on young players.
- players play for fun and enjoyment. Don’t ridicule mistakes.
- teach players that the rules of sport should be followed, not broken.
- develop team respect for opponents and officials from both teams.

#### Parents and Spectators Code of Behaviour.

- encourage players and accept results without disappointment.
- never ridicule or yell at a player for making mistakes or losing the game.
- players are involved for their enjoyment, not for their parents or spectators.
- volunteers deserve your respect and consideration.
- eliminate verbal and physical abuse from all sporting activities.

### **Players Code of Behaviour.**

- play by the rules.
- respect officials.
- abuse of opponents or officials is not allowed in any sport.
- treat all players the way you would like to be treated yourself.
- play for the “fun of it” and not just to please parents, spectators and coaches.
- respect the rights, dignity and worth of all players, coaches and officials.
- accept defeat with dignity and don't seek excuses for defeat or blame the referee or anyone else.
